On Friday October 11th, Professor Andy McIntosh lectured to the students, and friends who were able to join them, on **Creation**. He emphasised the importance of understanding the Biblical position: that God created everything, in six days, and human beings are special as we are created “in the image of God” with an immortal soul. His three topics were ‘How Science grew out of the Reformation’, ‘Why Creation is Theologically Important’ and ‘How True Science Points to the God of the Bible.’

On Saturday October 12th, the students were joined at their lectures by others interested in the Seminary for the **Visitors Lecture Day**. The day began with Malcolm Watts lecturing on ‘The Misery of Man’s Sinful State’, followed by David Kay lecturing on ‘Guidance’, Neil Pfeifer on ‘New Liberalism’ and John Thackway on ‘Some Biblical Priorities’, the day finished with Roland Burrows talking about ‘Selina, Countess of Huntingdon’
